ORDER

THIS MATTER having come before the Court on the application of Lamb McErlane, PC, and Moore & Van Allen, PLLC, attorneys for Defendant, Clear Blue Specialty Insurance Company (“Clear Blue”) for an Order, pursuant to Rule 4:6-2(e), dismissing Plaintiff’s Complaint against it with prejudice, and the Court having considered the papers submitted in support thereof, the Plaintiff’s opposition thereto, as well as oral argument from the parties conducted on December 15, 2022 and on August 3, 2023;


AND the Court having previously granted on December 15, 2022, the Motion of Clear Blue to Dismiss Count II of Plaintiff's Complaint for breach of contract,

AND for good cause otherwise shown:

IT IS ORDERED that Defendant Clear Blue's Motion to Dismiss Plaintiff's Complaint is hereby **GRANTED**. Count IX of Plaintiff's Complaint alleging aiding and abetting conversion and alleging aiding and abetting violations of the New Jersey RICO statute as against Clear Blue is dismissed with ^{CNT}prejudice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff's Complaint against Defendant Clear Blue is therefore hereby entirely dismissed with prejudice as to all counts against Defendant, Clear Blue Specialty Insurance Company.
