Analysis: We have put together the most up-to-date election results for your review.

There are some important items to note as you look over the results of the races above and begin to digest all the information.

President Barack Obama defeated Republican challenger Governor Mitt Romney. Obama got 50 percent of the votes while Romney received 48 percent across the United States. In North Carolina, Romney narrowly defeated President Obama.

The North Carolina Congressional races are all decided except for District 7. Democrat Mike McIntyre and challenger Republican David Rouzer are heading to a run off. Depending upon the outcome of the District 7 race, the new make-up of the North Carolina Congressional delegation will either be a 9-4 Republican majority or a 10-3 Republican majority.

At the state level, Republican Pat McCrory became the first Republican elected governor in 20 years having defeated Lieutenant Governor Walter Dalton. This is the first time the Republican party has complete control of lawmaking process in Raleigh since the 1800s. The Lt. Governor's race is still too close to call at this point. Democrat Linda Coleman has 2,181,646 votes and her opponent, Republican Dan Forest, has 2,193,016 votes as of now. It is unclear when the final tally will be announced.

Republicans seemed to have increased their margins in both the State House and the State Senate. Unofficial election results showed Republicans with a 77-43 advantage in the House and the Senate gained another seat giving the Republicans a 32-18 majority. With these new margins, both the House and Senate have veto-proof majorities. The Republican advantage in the House is currently 68-52 and it is 31-19 in the Senate.

In the Supreme Court, Justice Paul Newby defeated challenger Sam Ervin IV. Justice Newby received 52 percent of the vote to Ervin's 48 percent. There was a considerable amount of money raised by super PACs in this race, which may have had a significant impact in the outcome.
