Charleston Bankruptcy Member Robert A. Kerr, Jr. was elected to serve as secretary/treasurer of the South Carolina Bankruptcy Law Association's (SCBLA) 2013-2014 Executive Board.

The SCBLA is a not-for-profit organization formed to further bankruptcy legal education among attorneys practicing before the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of South Carolina.
