McDowell Named 2013 Citizen Lawyer

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Litigation Member Valecia McDowell was named a 2013 recipient of the North Carolina Bar Association's (NCBA) **Citizen Lawyer Award**. McDowell and the 12 other 2013 honorees were presented with their awards on Friday, June 21, at the NCBA Annual Meeting in Asheville.

The NCBA Citizen Lawyer Award was established in 2007 to recognize lawyers who provide exemplary public service to their communities. Honorees include elected and appointed government officials, coaches, mentors and voluntary leaders of nonprofit, civic and community organizations.

Smith Reynolds' Community Leadership Council.

Internally, McDowell serves as co-chair of Moore & Van Allen's Diversity Committee and is the immediate past co-chair of the Hiring Committee.
